His first book, *There There*, was a finalist for the 2019 Pulitzer Prize and received the 2019 American Book Award.

About the book: Wandering Stars delivers a masterful follow-up to his already classic first novel. Extending his constellation of narratives into the past and future, Tommy Orange traces the legacies of the Sand Creek Massacre of 1864 and the Carlisle Indian Industrial School through three generations of a family in a story that is by turns shattering and wondrous.
